

Kings Bridge Farm TSSA Show

Location: Kings Bridge Farm. From IH35, take FM 1431 (University Blvd.) east to CR 110. Turn left on CR 110, go approx. 1 mile until you come to CR 105 and turn right. Continue approx. 2 miles, you will go under the SH 130 overpass. KBF is approx. ½ mile farther on the left - 2195 CR 105.

Emergency Medical Technician: Fee is \$20.00. **Office Fee** is \$15.

Entries close at 8PM on the Friday before the show. Entries are accepted the day of the show, with a \$2 late fee per class entered. **Proof of negative Coggins is required.**

Membership requirements: All exhibitors must be members of the Texas Schooling Show Association. Memberships are \$20 for individuals, and \$25 for families. Memberships may be paid at the show.

Prizes: Champion/Reserve & Trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes in ring I (except Lead Line.) Certificates will be awarded for first thru sixth place and Champion/Reserve in all classes in ring II. Full TSSA points awarded in all classes except Lead Line.

Attire: Appropriate attire required. Coats optional. ALL riders must wear approved hard hats while mounted. This includes any area on the grounds. Numbers must be worn and visible.

Class 1: LEAD LINE - Open to very beginner riders. No TSSA points.

CROSS RAILS HUNTER

Open to all beginners. The course may be trotted or cantered. A horse may be used by more than one rider, and each horse and rider combination may receive championship and year-end points. If necessary, this division will be split to accommodate a large number of entries, or exhibitors sharing horses. *Rider may only cross-enter in 2' Warm-Up Hunter or 2' Warm-Up Equitation.*

Class 2: Cross Rails Hunter Warm-up

Class 3 & 4: Cross Rails Hunter

Class 5: Cross Rails Hunter U/S

CROSS RAILS EQUITATION

Open to all beginners. The course may be trotted or cantered. A horse may be used by more than one rider, and each horse and rider combination may receive championship and year-end points. If necessary, this division will be split to accommodate a large number of entries, or exhibitors sharing horses. *Rider may only cross-enter in 2' Warm-Up Hunter or 2' Warm-Up Equitation.*

Class 6: Cross Rails Equitation O/F

Class 7: Cross Rails Equitation (walk / trot only)

2' FUTURE HUNTER

Fences 2'. Open to beginner riders. The course will consist of simple fences, without a change of direction, and is to be cantered. Riders in this division who are also entered in any Cross Rails Hunter or Cross Rails Equitation classes are not eligible for any other TSSA divisions. Riders in this division who are NOT entered in any Cross Rails Hunter or Cross Rails Equitation classes may cross enter only into the 2' Hunter and 2' Equitation divisions.

2' FUTURE EQUITATION

Fences 2'. Open to beginner riders. The course will consist of simple fences, without a change of direction, and is to be cantered. Riders in this division who are also entered in any Cross Rails Hunter or Cross Rails Equitation classes are not eligible for any other TSSA divisions. Riders in this division who are NOT entered in any Cross Rails Hunter or Cross Rails Equitation classes may cross enter only into the 2' Hunter and 2' Equitation divisions.

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER

Fences 1'9". Open to beginner riders. The course will consist of simple fences, with a change of direction, and is to be cantered. Riders in this division may not enter into any other division aside from Intermediate Equitation.

INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION

Fences 1'9". Open to beginner riders. The course will consist of simple fences, with a change of direction, and is to be cantered. Riders in this division may not enter into any other division aside from Intermediate Hunter.

2' HUNTER

Fences 2'. Open to all horses and riders. The course will consist of simple fences, with a change of direction. This division will be split for year-end awards between riders 12 and younger and riders 13 and over.

GREEN HUNTER

Fences 2'6" Open to horses in their first or second year of showing which have never shown over fences 2'9" or higher at any show.

Fences 2'6". Open to all juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/06.

Fences 2'6". Open to all riders 18 years of age or older.

Fences 2'6". Open to all riders 18 years of age or older.

Class 40: Adult Equitation O/F Class 41: Adult Equitation Flat

Fences 2'6". Open to all horses and riders.

WORKING HUNTER

Fences 2'9". Open to all horses and riders.

Max. Fence Height 2'9". Open to all horses and riders.

Max. Fence Height 2'9". Open to all horses and riders. Each jump assigned a point value (5-20). Time allotted to be determined. Jumps knocked down are deducted from total score.
